Jeremy Alumbaugh Director of Soccer Operations

Springfield Soccer Club is proud to have Jeremy Alumbaugh serve as the Director of Soccer Operations. Alumbaugh will oversee all administrative and coaching duties for S.S.C. He returns to the Springfield soccer community after serving the last two and half years with the Chicago Magic S.C. which was recently rated the #2 youth soccer club in the United States by Soccer America. He served as a Full-Time Staff Coach and College Coordinator. "My wife and I are extremely excited about the opportunity to come back to Springfield. The chance to help guide the club into the future is a challenge I fully accept. The foundation for something special is definitely in place, a good coaching staff, including Carl Rose, Boys Director of Coaching, and most importantly dedicated players and families," states Alumbaugh.

Prior to coming to the Chicago Magic S.C. Alumbaugh served as the Director of Coaching for the Springfield Premier S.C. from 1990-2001. He was also the former

Assistant Men's Soccer Coach at Southwest Missouri State University and helped lead the Bears to the NCAA Division I Tournament appearances in 1997 and 1999. He was the top assistant at SMS from 1996-2000 where he was responsible for directing the recruiting efforts for SMS.

Alumbaugh attended the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh where he was a three year letterman. The Titans made NCAA Division III Tournament appearances in 1991, 1993, and in 1994 they advanced to the Final Four. He earned an undergraduate degree in Secondary Education Social Sciences, in 1995.

In 2002 and 2003 he served as an Assistant Coach for the

Chicago Fire Reserves who claimed the PDL Great Lakes Division title in 2002 and the Heartland Division in 2003. The 2003 Chicago Fire reserves made it all the way to the PDL National Championship. Currently five members of that Fire Reserves team play for the MLS.

Alumbaugh has spent time on the ODP State Staff for both Illinois and Wisconsin. He also has directed the Midwest Region Super Y League ODP program as the Head Scout. He currently has a USSF C License and a NSCAA National Diploma.

Alumbaugh and his wife Tammy are expecting their first child in November.
